

Shamrock Slime Is Always In Style

St. Patrick's Day may be over, but Shamrock Slime is fun all year round. Here's a how-to for this very simple craft.

Materials: 2 tsp borax, 1 ½ cups of water, 1 bottle of white school glue, green and yellow food coloring, glitter, mason jar, small bowl, medium bowl, large bowl, spoon

Step 1: Pour 1 cup of water into a small mixing bowl. Add 2 tsp of borax powder. Mix together until powder is dissolved and set aside.

Step 2: In medium bowl, pour the entire bottle of white school glue and 1/2 cup water. Stir until well blended.

Step 3: Add 5 drops of green food coloring and 2 drops of yellow food coloring to the glue mixture.

Step 4: Add a generous amount of glitter to the bowl and stir to mix it all together.

Step 5: Pour the contents of the small bowl into the center of the larger bowl and wait for the products to become solid.

Step 6: Then, using both hands, squish the slime together to make it more solid.

Step 7: Form it into a ball and pour the remaining liquid out.

The slime is now ready to be played with.
